Group Discounts Available

To encourage more Rotaract and Rotary Clubs to participate in the Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI), District 7620 and the Mid-Atlantic RLI Board created two group-discount programs to help defray RLI participation costs.

- 4 for 3 Program - If a Club sends four members to the same RLI event (any Part), the fourth participant is free. After the event, a reimbursement check is made out to the Club and sent to the Club Treasurer by the Mid-Atlantic RLI Division.
- 3 for 2 Program (RLI Part 1 Only) - If

a Club sends three members to the same RLI event for Part 1 only, the third participant is free. After the event, a reimbursement check is made out to the Club and sent to the Club Treasurer by the District 7620 Treasurer.
