Every year Rotary districts around the world sponsor high school 4-WayTest competitions. High school students, grades 9 through 12 are eligible to participate. Each contestant chooses the topic of his/her speech. The purpose of the speech is to persuade others while applying the principles of the Rotary 4-Way Test.

Important Dates:

You will be assigned a student ASAP. You will support your student through the stages of competition to include picking a topic, developing a speech, and honing the performance. You will help your student prepare a youtube video that they will submit to be judged, and if applicable, will help your student to prepare for their "live" virtual performance. You may also be asked to participate in youtube-judging, but you will not judge the student you mentor.

1. First round of judging: Students submit a youtube video by March 27. Judging of videos takes place on March 27th. Twelve students are selected to move forward.
2. Semifinal round of judging: Students submit a youtube video by April 10. Judging of videos takes place on April 10. Four students are selected to move forward.
3. Final round of judging takes place at the district's virtual annual conference, April 23-24. Students present "live". Conference attendees judge students and rank students (first through fourth).

Mentor Support:

- Video that explains how to prepare for a 4-WayTest competition and how a 4-WayTest competitor is judged
- On line videos of previous district 4-Way Test winners
- Rotarian support as needed related to mentoring
